In rain, the indoor area can comfortably accommodate an equal number of people, the absolute décor highlight being the chandelier suspended from the open roof truss, made of dozens of wine bottles. Mrs. Schwaighofer offers a cold buffet consisting of traditional Heuriger dishes and seasonal delicacies at 15 euros per person, all home-made. You can taste the restaurant's own wines. Friends of non-alcoholic beverages will get their fill with fruit juices made with produce from Schwaighofer's own orchards.
